

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on Overall Institutional Performance (2018-2019) – Analysis

Student Satisfaction Survey as a feedback was conducted in the institution by the college management to improve the standards of the institution and to cater the needs of the students. A questionnaire comprising 25 questions was prepared considering the key areas – Curriculum, Teaching and Learning process, College infrastructure and Community oriented Services on 5 point scale. The survey was conducted among 100 students of three years graduation using hard copies of questionnaire. Every student was given a questionnaire of 25 questions and asked to give their responses fairly. The students felt happy and gave their genuine replies for the action to be taken to enhance the standards of the college.

Most of the students were satisfied with the syllabus covered and the presentation styles of the teachers. Students were also satisfied with the methodology through which teaching and learning took place in the classroom. Students found teachers fair in internal evaluation process.

The teaching, mentoring process, curricular aspects, placement and library facilities were shown satisfactory by the most of the students. The students' feedback showed that the students agreed that the institution made a lot of efforts to engage them in developing their personality traits.

Out of the twenty five questions asked, the last question was about their overall opinion about the institution. The analysis was as follows:
